

In 2004, CGL was hired as the County's program manager to oversee the design and construction efforts for the new \$35 million (planned) Franklin County Jail. CGL led the planning effort to gather relevant and measurable justice data so Franklin County could build a jail with 200 fewer beds than rst anticipated. The change in scope saved the County about \$9 million in construction costs.

The new two-story, 130,000 square foot facility has 470 beds – three times the old jail - and is designed to add housing units without upgrades to the jail's infrastructure and administration. Franklin County used its savings to add a day reporting center for nonviolent offenders to provide life skills training and counseling services.

CGL currently provides Facility Maintenance at the Franklin County Jail and throughout the entire County.
